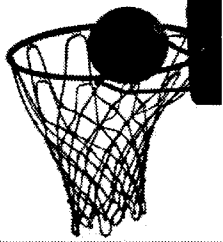

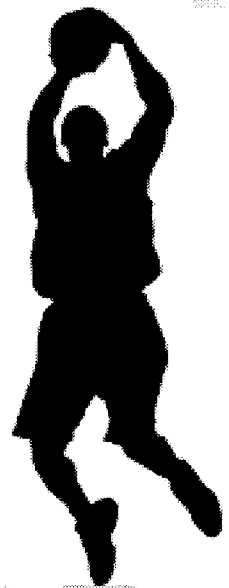

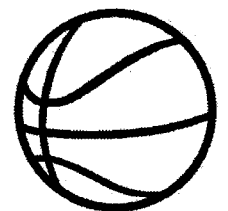

In Mexico the following Priests are just three of many that have been killed in recently months:

- 1) Rev. Gregorio Lopez Gorostieta is the latest Catholic priest to have been killed.
- 2) Rev. Ascension Acuna Osorio's battered body was found floating in the Balsas River near his Parish of San Miguel Toto.
- 3) Father John Ssenyondo, 55, from Ugandan was found in a clandestine grave in nearby Guerrero Diocese in November.

About 80 years ago the faithful in Mexico stood together and defended the Church and it's Religious, now it is all happening again.

80 years ago some of the people in the government decided that no other authority was needed other than what they decided. They took an active attack to oppress and even kill those who supported the Church and its policies of service to the public.

Sadly this is not a new development as in recent years Priests serving around the Globe have fallen victim to robbers.

In a recent case a Spanish Priest and his Sister, who was a Nun also stationed in the same village in North Africa to serve the local village fell prey to local bandits. This Priest was shot, losing his leg. A fellow Priest was killed and his Sister were also severely injured. The Spanish Military airlifted all the injured to safety and medical care.

They returned to Spain for medical care and while recovering vowed to return. Both the Priest & his Sister returned to the very village and the people that they hoped to continue to serve.

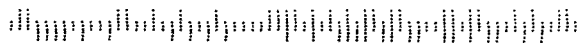
